Sub : Provisional List of categorization of manufacturers of insecticides year 2015-16.

To keep a track record of quality of insecticides being sold/supplied in the State by various insecticide manufacturers/formulators, this Department has made a detailed exercise to categorize them into A, B, C, N (New) and Non-Descriptive categories based upon samples found standard & sub-standard during the period 2010-11 to 2014-15. The criteria for categorization is given under Annexure-I. The purpose of such categorization is to ensure effective sampling and to observe an Internal Quality Control Mechanism and an advisory to inspectors as well as manufacturers.

Based upon above criteria & the sample records available with Department, a provisional list of manufacturers falling into above categories is provided under Annexure-II.

If any manufacturer is aggrieved by the categorization and wants to adduce evidence about any change required in its category, may submit a representation to Joint Director of Agriculture (Plant Protection) Raj. Jaipur within next 15 days from the day of issuance of this letter. All representations, so received, will be decided within next one month and final list be issued. Thereafter, no changes will be entertained.

We urge upon all the registered/licensed manufacturers to file their representations within the stipulated time period to change, if any change is warranted.

Annexure-I**Criteria adopted for categorization in 2015-16**

SN	Category	Criteria for categorization (No. of samples analyzed during last 5 years)
1	'A' [Good track of quality record]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • More than 60 samples • Of them, up to 3% substandard samples
2	'B' [Satisfactory track of quality record]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • More than 60 samples with greater than 3-5 % sub standard samples. • >15-60 samples with up to 3% sub standard samples.
3	'C' [Needs further improvement in track of quality record]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Greater than 60 samples with more than 5-10% sub standard samples. • >15-60 samples with 3-5% sub standard samples. • Up to 15 samples with no sub standard samples.
4	'N'	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Entrants. • No samples analyzed
5	N.D. (Non-Descriptive manufacturers)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manufacturers those do not fall under any categories listed above.
